Хочется нового пространства. В дистанционке, в очной школе, на территории бывшего Советского Союза. Иногда думаем, что очень медленно движемся. Поздно принимаем решения. Скорее всего, и так. Хотя хочется верить, что просто «всему своё время».

## Robert Neild

Robert and Ann Neild were one of the first missionaries to come to Kiev and starting doing the training as no one else did before. Ann had two years of experience as an ABC Supervisor when she responded to God's call along with Robert. What they did with the training was really different. They wanted for their trainees to experience all the intricacies of the real Learning Center while being "students". The training lasted not less than two weeks. The longest took 5 weeks. Just 3 trainees lasted that long. The final sessions were held at Robert and Ann's home. Later on it was Yekaterinburg. Old timers still remember total commitment to excellence instituted by the Neilds. Kazakhstan. When Robert and Ann contacted me and said they were considering going to Almaty I did not hesitate to ask them to be our representation there... Stories go on. # SCHOOL OF TOMORROW REGIONAL STUDENT CONVENTION

I learned about this event somewhere between 1996 and 1997. When I came from city of Vladimir, where I used to work, to get some educational materials from the Model School of Tomorrow (former name of the International School of Tomorrow), I met Len Stolyarchuk and Michael Showalter.

They told me about the idea of conducting the first convention of the School of Tomorrow in the CIS and Baltic States. It sounded quite interesting; however no one understood how it would happen and no one imagined it would become a twenty-five year long story.

Nevertheless, the administration of the school represented by the Principal Julie Avdoshina and Vice-Principal Galina Burlakova did like the idea. Moreover, the parents were also eager to do it. At that time as we gathered teams for the convention we also studied the Convention Manual. With considerable difficulty we tried to understand the requirements for convention events, studied American judges' forms and tried to figure out how the points are given and why they are taken away.



As a result we overcame all fears and difficulties and departed for our first Student Convention. Most of the events took place in Moscow, Domodedovskaya street, 44. However, we also rented a hall not far away for the other events.

First performances, first victories, as well as award ceremonies and choosing the "School of Convention". You were not there!? Do not worry. Watch the following video!



And so the convention kept going. It hosted teams from different countries and we also managed to go to England for the European conventions and the USA for international ones.

You would think that nothing can surprise us after going through with 10, 20, and even 30 conventions ... However that is why this world is so interesting to live in – it can surprise you anytime.

March 2020. Because of the coronavirus pandemic we faced a lot of limitations: borders closed, events got cancelled... Nevertheless we hoping to keep the convention off line no matter what. However,



on March 13 it was decided to postpone the events. We wanted to postpone, not to cancel. We were sure that things would get back to normal soon. But unfortunately the situation in the world kept getting worse.

And at the beginning of the new academic year, still with restrictions and other circumstances, we at the International School of Tomorrow were pondering about the fate of the Convention. There were various proposals, often completely opposite to each other. In addition, last summer our children took part in one American online Convention. As a result, taking into account all circumstances, on October 7, the following news appeared on the website of the International School of Tomorrow:

*The 24th Regional Student Convention for schools in Moscow, regions of Russian Federation, CIS and Baltic states will take place online starting October 12, 2020 until April 15, 2021.*

*The Statutes of the convention are based on the Student Convention Manual. The criteria necessary for each nomination is in this manual taking into account the remote format of the event.*

New format, new challenges, new expectations. No one really knew how it would go and whether it would be technically possible. We also did not know if the students

will be interested and the teachers inspired. To be honest, many in our own school doubted the idea was great.

Nevertheless, day by day, step by step the team kept moving ahead. Students and teachers from different schools and cities such as Moscow, Vladimir, Khabarovsk, Vladivostok, Minsk, Shymkent, Ekaterinburg also got connected. We had 287 applicants overall. Moreover, thanks to the students of the International School of Tomorrow from Vietnam, Zimbabwe, USA, Uganda, India, Nepal, Azerbaijan, Cameroon, South Sudan, Taiwan, Afghanistan, Turkey, Nigeria, Iran, Philippines, and Namibia our Convention became traditionally International.





Online meetings, sending and uploading performances through different online platforms, websites, email and messengers. Calls, message exchanges and millions of questions. Quite similar to what it was like twenty-five years ago. There was just one difference: the world keeps developing and communication has become much easier.

Six months of Convention passed by like one day and finally we approached the Award Ceremonies! They were held online for most of the participants. However, at the International School of Tomorrow in Moscow we had the pedestals and the medals and gifts were given live. So many positive emotions!

Всем привет.

Меня зовут Ксения Николаева, мне 12 лет. И сейчас я немножко расскажу о себе и том, как я стала девочкой «Московской конвенции». Я довольно разносторонний человек, и я очень часто участвую в различных конкурсах и олимпиадах, но именно в «Московской конвенции» я мечтала победить с четвёртого класса. Подготовила меня Пушкарёва Виктория Игоревна.

Практически каждый день я оставалась после уроков и готовилась к словарному диктанту, но больше всего времени я потратила на репетицию диалога со своим братом. Во-первых, там надо работать в команде, а иногда это не так-то просто. Во-вторых, я обратила внимание, что в этой номинации всегда очень много участников, поэтому чтобы занять первое место, нужно было сделать всё идеально. # Parent AcceleGRAM: Achievement in School Begins at Home



As parents you want your child to achieve in school. Although you probably can't be with your child at school each day, there are some definite things you can do to help him be successful.

## **PRAISE HIM!**

When your child brings home a Congratulations slip, praise him for his accomplishment. You might even offer him a special treat for passing test scores.

Other achievements worthy of praise are those relating to character. Has your child earned a privilege level or demonstrated good behavior? Be sure he knows what you expect and that you are pleased when he exemplifies Christlike character. Godly character is the goal of Biblical education.

## **HELP HIM!**

When your child has PACE homework, do not give him answers or do the work for him. Help him by providing encouragement and direction to find the answers. Set specific parameters concerning when and where homework will be done. Require "break time" if needed, and find ways to reward his diligence when finishing without procrastination. Remember: character counts!

When the staff sends home a communication envelope, read the contents and be sure to sign the envelope. Then encourage your child to take responsibility for returning it to school the next day. This envelope is one

of the most effective ways the school has of communicating with you, and it is your opportunity to work with the staff to encourage your child to learn responsibility.

Occasionally your child may have an assignment for a project to complete at home. Time spent working on a project with your child is never wasted. By helping him you reinforce the importance of his diligence in achieving a goal and doing his best on every task. You also nonverbally reinforce your love and respect for him.

Your child may occasionally receive a detention or become upset when receiving demerits at school. You can help by assuring that you love him, even though you do not approve of his behavior, and by encouraging him to do better.

Help your child learn respect by supporting the school staff's decisions and discipline. Never side with your child against the staff or side with the staff

against him. CHECK THE FACTS before responding emotionally to his statements or complaints. Remember, the child's perspective and that of the staff may be different.

A "morning checklist" can help you train your child in taking responsibility and can help prevent those desperate calls from school because he has forgotten something. A good start will help the day go smoothly.

### LOVE HIM!

A child who knows he is loved is much better prepared to concentrate on learning. It is impossible to tell him too often that you love him, and he needs more than just words. Tone of voice, hugging, and touching are just as important as what is said.

Another way to show love for your child is to pray with him and for him. Remind him that God loves him and has a perfect plan for his life.
